1. **Online Course Requests:** You will be required to input your course requests online at <https://studentconnect.cnusd.k12.ca.us> prior to meeting with your counselor. The online registration portal opens **January 24, 2023** and closes **February 10, 2023**. Please see your Language Arts teacher for directions and student portal questions.
2. 10th grade students need to select **6 classes per semester** online through “Q”.
3. All 10th grade students must take Language Arts 2a/b, World History 1a/b, Math and Physical Science.
4. Refer to Santiago’s *Shark Scheduler* online (bit.ly/3huCdKh) for all course descriptions and prerequisites.
5. **HONORS and ADVANCED PLACEMENT COURSES**
 - Students must meet the prerequisite requirements and teacher consultation is recommended.
 - Students are responsible for completing required summer assignments.
 - Students **must** complete the **Honors/Advanced Placement Contract** and return it to their counselors’ Google classroom. Contracts are available online at www.santiagocounseling.com/resources and in the Counseling Center.
6. Students interested in Dual Enrollment (college courses) need to contact their counselor.
7. All students will have the opportunity to meet individually with their counselor to review and finalize their course selections to ensure graduation and/or to meet subject admission requirements to the Cal State University or University of California.
