UC/CSU A-G Requirements	
Pass all required classes with a C- or better! You <i>must</i> repeat any course in which you earn a D+ or below for A-G Eligibility.	
Subject:	Minimum Requirement:
(A) History	2 years
(B) Language Arts	4 years
(C) Mathematics	3 years
(D) Lab Science (1 yr. Life & 1 yr.	2 years
(E) World Language	2 years
(F) Visual or Performing Arts	1 year
(G) College Prep Elective	1 year
