





UC APPLICATION

FACT 1:

UC Application is the only application that all 9 UC's will accept.

FACT 2:

Application is only available online via desktop or mobile view.



FACT 3:

Every campus that a student has applied to, will receive the application but will review it individually.

FACT 4:

No interviews or external materials needed (i.e. resumes).

FACT 5:

By invitation only: letters of recommendation, portfolios, auditions.

BEFORE APPLYING

Make sure to have the following information prepared before applying.

- 1. Transcript
- 2. Test Scores*
- 3. Annual Income
- 4. Social Security Status
- 5. Citizenship Status
- 6. California statewide student ID.
 - Each K-12 student in California public schools is assigned an ID number. If it's not printed on your transcript, ask your counselor or registrar.
- 7. Credit Card



Commonly Asked Questions

What if a student has very strong scores? Can they ask for them to be considered?

No. Under no circumstances will scores be used for selection.

Can a student submit test scores if they already took the exam?

Yes, but only for placement or clearing an A-G requirement. Scores will NOT be used for selection.

Do campuses see scores when reviewing applications if a student submits them?

No, campuses receive scores only AFTER all admission/waitlist activity ends.

Is the GPA getting more attention since you have no scores?

Slightly, but don't forget that there are 13 Comprehensive Review factors.

Deadline	Step to Enrollment
August 1	Create a UC application
November 1-30	Submit UC application
Mid-March	View admission notification
May 1	Submit Statement of Intent to Register (SIR)

Exam Requirements: UC will not consider SAT or ACT test scores when making admissions decisions or awarding scholarships. If you choose to submit test scores as part of your application, they may be used as an alternative method of fulfilling minimum requirements for eligibility or for course placement after you enroll. **CLICK HERE**





TIPS & ADVICE FOR STUDENTS:

- Remember, grades are more indicative of your preparation than performance on one exam!
- > Take courses that interest and challenge you.
- Write multiple PIQ drafts. Eliminate "fluff." No need for creative writing, just talk to us!
- Consider completing "optional" questions (i.e., parents level of education, family size, etc.) to provide greater personal context.
- Don't use the "Additional Information" box in the PIQ section to list extracurricular activities complete the activity section!
- Context matters! Tell us about your life. What courses do you have access to and why you have or haven't taken advantage of them?
- Be thorough and accurate with your grade reporting. Work from a transcript!
